**** The COOEE program is heavily subsidised so fees may change depending on student numbers and subsidies received.**

NOTE 1: This cost does not include options such as Deep Sea Fishing (approximately \$110), Marine Radio Licence (\$94), First Aid Cert (\$90), Scuba Diving (approximately \$350), Medical Certificate or Boat Licence Fee.

NOTE 2: Some VET course fees (Certificate I and II) are covered by state government funding. This means that a student can enrol in the course of study and not be charged for the delivery of that program. This is called VETiS funding. A student is eligible for only one VETiS funded program. Some RTOs can provide VET fee help for students.

NOTE 3: Certificate course prices are current at time of publication.
