Please note the following important information:

VENUE: Elanora SHS

DATES: GC5 2020

- Round 1: Term 1 – Week 7 (11th March)
- Round 2: Term 2 – Week 2 (29th April)
- Round 3: Term 2 – Week 7 (3rd June)
- Round 4 – Term 3 – Week 2 (22nd July)
- Round 5 – Term 3 – Week 4 (5th August)
- Wet weather day Term 3 – Week 5 (12th August) only if needed
- World of Sport South Coast Finals -Term 3: Week 6 – 19th August

RISK: Low

TRANSPORT: Students will meet in sport classroom for roll marking and practice, at 10am the chess competition will commence and continue until 2pm. Students will be supervised until 2.30pm at which time students depart for home.

UNIFORM: Students will attend and play in the school sport uniform.

FIRST AID: First aid will be provided at this venue by teaching staff.

WHAT TO BRING: Hat, sunscreen & water bottle. All players need to bring snack food & lunch for the day as there is no guarantee of the amount or type of food available at the canteen.

COACH: Mel Knight

CONDITIONS: The inherent risk for this activity is low, the competition follows normal chess rules, students will compete as individuals and participate in a double elimination competition. Students will play a minimum of two and a maximum of 4 games on the day. Students will be instructed in the rules and strategies of chess in the morning before beginning the double elimination competition.
