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Curriculum Offerings - Year 8 2019

Sand Form

- Students study up to three electives for the year.
- Music is a full year elective. All other electives are for one semester.
- Electives include Business, Digital Media, Digital Technology, Drama, Food and Nutrition, Hospitality, Industrial Technology, Music and Visual Art.
- Students requiring additional support in Literacy and Numeracy will be withdrawn from an elective and placed in an Intensive Literacy and Numeracy class.
