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BYOD – The Journey

- 2015 Initial BYOD class + ACE class – Year 7 + Year 8 ACE – total **90 students**
- 2016 BYOD + ACE – Year 7, 8 & 9 – total **150 students**
- 2017 BYOD (2) + ACE + SPORT – Year 7, 8 & 9 – total **250 students - 50 % of the Year 7 cohort**
- Provisions have also been made for students in Year 10 in regards to continuing with the use of their device and support from the school in regards to security & technical support.

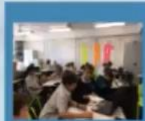

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FAQ's

- Will I need to purchase a new device?

No. If you currently have a device that meets the minimum recommended standards, then that will be fine.

- Who can take part in the program?

At this stage, we are offering BYOD in the ACE classes (year 7) and there will be a general entry BYOD offered in year 7.

- How much will it cost?

The BYOD program will have an annual connection fee of \$75. This covers the connection to the network, laptop locker hire and some specialist software.



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FAQ's

- What are the minimum specifications for a device?

Minimum Hardware Requirements	
CPU:	Intel: Core i3 (preferably i5)
RAM:	4 GB Minimum
Graphics:	Intel Built-in graphics acceptable
Storage:	320 GB HDD (or 128 GB SSD) Optical Drive optional
Network:	Wireless: 802.11n compatible built-in. Ethernet adaptor recommended
Screen Size:	13 to 15 inch recommended 1280 x 720 minimum resolution 11 inch minimum/15+ inch not recommended.
Battery life:	4.5 hour minimum battery life

- Will my device need to be customised for this program?

No. The device will need minimum customisation to join/interact with the network. It will retain its user customisations.

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FAQ's

- What technical support is offered?

The school will cover all technical issues arising from connecting the device to our network. There will also be some support staff available to troubleshoot any issues that arise during the school day.

Beyond that, students are responsible for the day-to-day upkeep and maintenance of the device they bring to school



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FAQ's

- Do you offer any help/support in purchasing a device?

Beyond the minimum specifications, students are free to choose the device that best suits them for the program.

On the [BYOD webpage](#) (on our school's website), there are a range of purchasing portals that may be used by parents who are looking to buy a device.

This is a good place to start, as the arrangements on there are designed specifically with the BYOD student in mind.



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BYOD 2018 - Registration

- Students who have been offered and accepted a place in ACE 2018 in Year 7 will automatically be in a BYOD class.
- Students who have been offered and accepted a place in Sport 2018 in Year 7 will automatically be in a BYOD class.
- Students who applied for ACE and have accepted a place on the waiting list will be in BYOD classes.



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BYOD 2018 - Registration

- There is no selection process for the Year 7 general BYOD class – simply complete and lodge an online Expression of Interest - opens tonight, pay deposit & complete the enrolment process and ensure you have a BYOD that matches the program requirements for the start of 2018.
